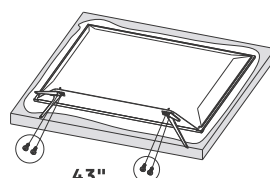
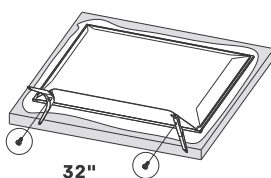
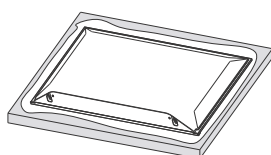
Stand Installation

Note: The pictures are only for reference.

Step 1: Take out the TV and carefully put it (screen downward) on a stable and flat table with a soft cloth or cushion on it.

Step 2: Please check to make sure there is the same mark (A/B) on the TV back and the correct stand base. This step is not available for the bases without any mark on them, or not available for the TV with one stand base only.

Step 3: Fix the stand bases to the TV by fastening the matching stand screws provided in the box. The bases may vary depending on the region or model.


Important Safety Instructions

- Read these instructions – All the safety and operating instructions should be read before this product is operated.
- Keep these instructions – The safety and operating instructions should be retained for future reference.
- Heed all warnings – All warnings on the appliance and in the operating instructions should be adhered to.
- Follow all instructions – All operating and use instructions should be followed.
- Do not use this apparatus near water – The appliance should not be used near water or moisture – for example, in a wet basement or near a swimming pool, and the like.
- Clean only with dry cloth.

Positioning the TV

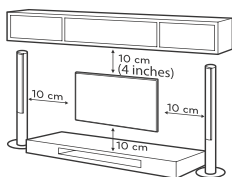

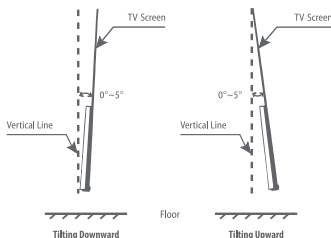

Mounting on a Wall

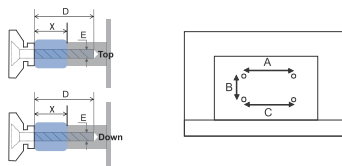
● An optional wall mount can be used with your TV. Consult with your local dealer to purchase the recommended wall mount bracket. Carefully attach the wall mount bracket at the rear of the TV. Install the wall mount bracket on a solid wall perpendicular to the floor. If you are attaching the TV to other building materials, please contact qualified personnel to install the wall mount. Detailed instructions will be included with the wall mount. Please use a wall mount bracket where the device is adequately secured to the wall with enough space to allow connectivity to external devices.



- To prevent product damages or personal injuries, please make sure that the TV screen is kept upright, or tilted upward or downward within the angle range of $0^{\circ} \sim 5^{\circ}$ while mounting the TV onto the wall.
- In case of exceeding the angle range ($0^{\circ} \sim 5^{\circ}$) of tilting downward, please purchase the auxiliary accessories from the local dealer to mount the TV for safe installation and usage. Otherwise, it will not be covered by the warranty and the user should be liable for all consequences and responsibilities.



- Disconnect the power before moving or installing the TV. Otherwise electric shock may occur.
- Remove the stand before installing the TV on a wall mount by performing the stand attachment in reverse.
- If you install the TV on a ceiling or slanted wall, it may fall and result in severe injury. Use an authorized wall mount and contact the local dealer or qualified personnel. Otherwise it is not covered by the warranty.
- Do not over tighten the screws as this may cause damage to the TV and void your warranty.
- To prevent injury, this apparatus must be securely attached to the floor/wall in accordance with the installation instructions.
- Use the screws and wall mounts that meet the following specifications. Any damages or injuries by misuse or using an improper accessory are not covered by the warranty.

Warnings and Precautions

Note:

- 1) The pictures are for reference only.
- 2) For the TV sets with terminals facing towards the wall, in order to leave enough space to use the terminals, a rubber cushion is needed together with the screw to fix the wall mount. It is a small hollow pillar of which the height is $\geq 30\text{mm}$.

Operating Environment

- . Do not install this equipment in a confined space such as a bookcase or similar unit.
- . Do not use the set near damp, and cold areas, protect the set from overheating.
- . Keep away from direct sunlight.
- . Do not use the set near dust place.
- . Do not attach candle to accessible opening area, to avoid flammable foreign material from entering the TV.

Precautions for Using Remote Control

- . Use the remote control by pointing it towards the remote sensor. The items between the remote control and the remote sensor will interfere the normal operation.
- . Do not make remote control vibrate violently. Also, do not splash liquid on the remote control, also do not put the remote control in high humidity place.
- . Do not place remote control under direct sunlight which will cause deformation of the unit by heat.
- . When the remote sensor is under direct sunlight or strong lighting, the remote control will not work. If so please change the lighting or TV's position, or operate the remote control closer to the remote sensor.

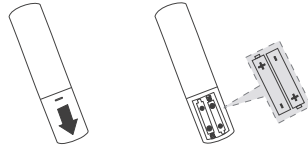
Precautions for Using Battery

Improper using of the battery will cause leakage. So please do as the following methods and use carefully.

1. Please note the batteries' polarity, to avoid short circuit.
2. When the battery's voltage is insufficient which affect the use range, you should replace new battery. Remove the batteries from the remote control unit if you do not intend to use it for a long time.
3. Do not use different types of batteries (for example, Manganese and Alkaline batteries) together.
4. Do not put the battery into fire, and charge or decompose the battery.
5. Please dispose batteries abide by relevant environmental protection regulation.
6. WARNING: The batteries (battery pack or batteries installed) shall not be exposed to excessive heat such as sunshine, fire or the like.

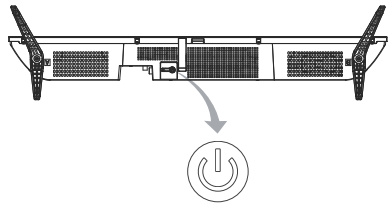

Remote Control

1. POWER ()

- Long press this button to start receiving your voice command. After your speaking, release this button to run voice function.

3. Profile ()

Sign in with your Google account to get the entertainment you love.

4. Dashboard ()

Access the dashboard menu of your Google TV™.

5. OK

Confirm, enter or execute the selected item, or access the channel list.

6. Navigation Buttons (UP/DOWN/LEFT/RIGHT)

- Navigate the menu to select the content you need, or
- Press UP/DOWN button to change channels.

7. HOME ()

Access the home screen.

8. EPG ()

Access DTV or access the Electronic Program Guide in DTV mode.

9. BACK ()

Return to upper-level content, or exit the current screen or operation.

10. MUTE ()

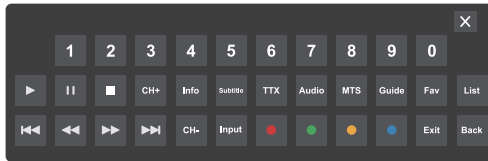

Electronic Program Guide is supplied by the program providers and offers information about the programs to be broadcast. You can access it in DTV mode by pressing **EPG** (📺) button on the remote control.

- * Press **RED** button in the virtual keyboard to check the program information of previous day.
- * Press **GREEN** button in the virtual keyboard to check the program information of next day.
- * (May not be available) Press **YELLOW** button in the virtual keyboard to check more detailed information of the current program.
- * Press **BLUE** button in the virtual keyboard to select the desired program type.

Basic Features

Time-shift

Time-shift is used to record a DTV program when your viewing is interrupted or delayed. To enable or disable the Time-shift function, please select < **SOURCE** () button → Shortcuts → TV Menu → Record → Time Shift Mode > in DTV mode. After the Time-shift function has been enabled, press **Pause** () button in the virtual keyboard to pause playing the DTV program and start to record the program. Press **Play** () button in the virtual keyboard to continue playing the program from when you paused. Press **EXIT** button in the virtual keyboard to call out a prompt reminder, asking you whether or not to stop the time-shift function.

Note:

- 1) *Before time-shift, you'd better format your USB storage device to ensure there is enough space for time-shift recording. If you have any data saved on your USB storage device, please back up the data before formatting it. Formatting a USB storage device will erase all data saved on the USB storage device*
- 2) *The recorded program of time-shift will be cleared automatically after playing the program or stopping time-shift function.*
- 3) *If time-shift recording lasts too long, and there is no more space for recording new program, the TV will start to play the program automatically from the recording beginning to release the space of program which has been played for new program recording.*

User Settings

Initial Setup

When you turn on the TV for the first time, there will show a wizard to guide you to finish the following settings.

Step 1: Connect the Bluetooth® remote control.

Step 2: Select the menu language as you need.

Step 3: Select your region or country.

Step 4: Select to setup Google TV or setup basic TV. It is suggested that you select "Setup Google TV" to enjoy full smart features of your Google TV.

after setup google account

* TV will request automatic channel scan even if was done before. So, need to setup Google account before using TV functions.

*** For some countries, you can use your mobile phone or TV remote control to setup Google TV. If you prepare to setup the TV with your mobile phone, please operate according to on-screen instructions of both the TV and your phone. If you prepare to setup the TV with TV remote control, please select "Set up on TV instead"; and then go on with the following step. ***

Step 5: Connect your TV to the desired wireless network.

Step 6: Sign in with your Google account.

Step 7: Read to accept the Google terms of services and privacy policy.

Step 8: Read to accept the Google services settings.

Step 9: Learn the main feature of Google Assistant and select "Continue" to go to the next step.

Step 10: Select whether or not to let Google Assistant search across all your applications.

Step 11: Select to install the recommended applications from Google. This step may not be available depending on the Google service.

Step 12: Turn on or turn off the LCN (Logical Channel Number) switch.

Step 13: Setup the password for the parental lock system.

Step 14: Choose the TV usage environment between "Home" and "Shop". "Home" mode is recommended for normal home viewing, while "Shop" mode is used to demonstrate the TV in a shop and the like. It will consume more energy in "Shop" mode.

Step 15: Select the tuner mode.

Step 16: Start "Channel Scan".

Step 17: Read to accept the end user license agreement.

Step 18: Install your apps.

Step 19: Start exploring your Google TV.
