How to Use


1. Turn On/Off



2. Bluetooth Connection
Search & click 'SOUNARC A1' to connect.



3. Disconnect from Bluetooth
Press the 'Mode' button for 3s to disconnect from Bluetooth.

4. USB-A Power Bank Function
This speaker carries a USB charge-out function that will automatically detect your device and begin to charge it when the charging cable is plugged into the USB-A port under powering-on mode.


5. Aux-in Mode
Simply connect the speaker with your non-Bluetooth device via the 3.5 mm audio jack cable.

Note: After plugging in an audio cable, the speaker will automatically switch to Aux-in mode.


6. USB Flash Drive Mode
The speaker will play the music from your U-disk when plugging into the slot.

7. TF/Micro SD Card Slot Mode
The speaker will play the music from your TF/Micro SD card when plugging the card into the slot. The maximum supported memory is 128 GB.

8. Karaoke Mode
Double press 'Mode' button to enter/exit karaoke mode.




9. True Wireless Stereo Mode
A. Turn on both speakers and make sure they haven't connected with any device.
B. Press 'Stereo Pairing' button once of either speaker to enter stereo pairing mode.
C. If paired successfully, the stereo pairing indicator of both speakers will stay yellow. The Bluetooth indicator of host speaker will flash while the vice one will off.
D. Search & click 'SOUNARC A1' to connect.
E. Press 'Stereo Pairing' button once of either speaker to exit stereo pairing mode.



10. Charging

Red Light On	Charging
Goes Off	Charging Completion
Red Light Flashes	Battery Low

11. Reset
Press 'Mode' button for 8s.



12. Instruction of Wireless Microphone
A. Battery display: 3 layers indicates fully charged; blank means battery low.
B. Red indicator stays on indicates MIC is get fully charged.
C. It is highly suggested that you drain up the battery before charging for the first use.
D. The frequency of 2 MICS are different to avoid the interfere.

13. Auto Power Off
The speaker will power off automatically after 10 minutes if it does not pair with any device through Bluetooth. When in low battery, the speaker will power off automatically as well.

Care & Maintenance

-Do not use any form of detergents or cleaning material to clean the product as any type of chemical may make this device unusable.
-Do not disassemble this product. It contains no user serviceable parts.
-Do not drop or jump on it and treat it with care for the best performance.
